27th October, The Hotel, Brussels*

Are you doing a postgraduate research project in the field of renewable or other low-carbon gas? Why not promote your project in front of a high-level audience and possibly win a substantial prize?

GERG, the European Gas Research Group, has established a Young Researchers' event to promote interaction, specifically on R&D topics, and to enlarge and strengthen links between selected universities and the European gas industry's research centres.

The key objectives are to encourage a dialogue between industry practitioners and academia and to raise awareness and enhance interaction between our different communities.

The 2017 event will take place in association with the Eurogas Annual Conference on 27th October in Brussels. The theme of the Conference this year will be Renewable Gases, and an audience of over a hundred industry executives and policy makers is expected.

The event will be based on presentations of post-graduate projects in the conference session and as posters.

Support by GERG for students and supervisors will be provided as follows:

- 6 abstracts will be selected for presentation as posters and in 5 minute conference slots.
- Support for travel and accommodation for successful students will be provided up to a limit of €700.
- Two prizes of €1,500 will be awarded for the best presentations as assessed by senior GERG and Eurogas members.

You are eligible if you are a post-graduate student working towards a PhD or Master's degree relevant to the gas industry.

- the opportunity to present and discuss your work in front of a high-level audience
- the opportunity to engage with the gas industry and policy makers
- the opportunity to win a substantial prize
- the opportunity to meet a potential employer,

Please send us:

- a one-page abstract describing the work you would like to present, *on the subject of renewable or other low-carbon gas (including biomethane, bioSNG, hydrogen and power to gas)*;
- preferably a short video of no more than 5 minutes in which you present yourself and describe the project
